he first Independent Media Center was established in November 1999 by alternative media activists to provide coverage of the World Trade Organization protests in Seattle.

The Seattle Independent Media Center became a clearing


The Seattle Independent Media Center became a clearing house of information for journalists, and provided up-to-the-minute reports, photos, audio and video footage through its website and satellte linkups. It used a democratic **open-publishing** system to produce video documentaries, a newspaper and a 24-hour micro radio station. Meanwhile www.indymedia.org logged more than 2 million hits before the last whiff of tear-gas had dispersed.

Since the N30 'Battle In Seattle', thousands of independent media makers have set up Independent Media Centers in their communities. There are now over a hundred and fifty local IMCs covering six continents where they provide safe spaces for independent news through web sites, print, radio, video and many other media.
